



# AWO Provincial Competition 2019

## May 10-12, Brock University

Dear Club Representative,

This document outlines the entry procedure for the 2019 AWO Provincial Competition and contains the forms that require completion. Please read **all** the following information carefully and share it with members of your club who will be responsible for preparing your club's AWO entries.

**Everything you need to complete your club's entries is contained in this document!  
Instructions and necessary documents are included.**

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Entry in the AWO Provincial Competition has 3 main parts:

- 1. Entry Certificate**
- 2. On-line Entry**
- 3. Club Registration Form and Payment**

A competition of 700+ wines requires a great deal of volunteer time and effort. The AWO Executive, Wine Judges of Canada and many stewards are all working as a team to make sure the 2019 competition is as fair, transparent and professional as possible. Please observe all deadlines for submission of your entries. Sending your club's entry information and payment immediately following your club competition will help keep the competition preparations on schedule.

# AWO Provincial Competition Entry Procedure

## 1. Entry Certificate

All Gold and Silver wines from the Club Competition should be listed and signed by a judge or judges.

**THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE COMPLETED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE CLUB COMPETITION.**

- Arrange the entries by class and winemaker to make the verification process easier.
  - You may reproduce the Entry Certificate electronically from a spreadsheet, as long as it contains the same information and is signed by the judges at your club competition.
  - The completed Entry Certificate with judges' signatures can be mailed or scanned and sent electronically.
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## 2. On-line Entry Registration

Each wine in the 2019 AWO Provincial Competition **must be entered on-line**. A link to the entry form will be sent to clubs in late January. It will also be posted on the Makewine.com website under the **Competitions** tab.

### Important!

Even though individual winemakers are responsible for entering their own wines in the competition, clubs will still need to keep track of the total number of entries. This number must agree with the total number of entries on the Club Registration Form.

### Deadline for on-line entries is April 7.

- Please observe the deadline! Timely submission of entries is appreciated.
  - Submissions received after April 7 will be accepted at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
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## 3. Entry Registration Form and Payment

Complete this form once you have finalized your club entries. **The number of entries indicated on the Club Registration Form must be the same as the number of wines entered on-line.**
